The 4th Biennial Homelessness Research Symposium

Calgary Homeless Foundation is seeking presenters for **Research to Action, the 4th Biennial Homeless Research Symposium, on April 19th and 20th, 2017**. The event will be held at Fort Calgary at 750 9 Ave SE, Calgary, AB T2G 5E1.

The Homelessness Research Symposium is a two-day event that will bring together researchers, service providers, government officials, and our community to discover ways to transform Research to Action.

We are inviting proposal submissions from individuals in Alberta and beyond who have conducted or are currently conducting research pertaining to homelessness in the Canadian context. Specifically:

- Academic researchers (qualitative or quantitative)
- Researchers in government and system planning organizations
- Researchers and others in community-based service-providing agencies

The submission deadline is **February 20, 2017**.

General Presentation Information

The question we are aiming to answer at this year's Homeless Research Symposium is: **"What research is being done and how can we transform that research and data into successful action plans?"**

Each presentation should foster thought provoking questions and generate discussion around homelessness research. Presenters will describe and discuss their projects: what they've done, what they've learned, and how others can use what's been learned to advance their own work.

Those selected to make presentations will be given free admission to the event. It is expected that all presenters are willing to have their presentations filmed, and presentations put online.
